

Unit 2: The scientific community

Vocabulary: Ryuchi's notes about how chocolate can relieve stress

1. Healthy- In a good physical or mental condition; in good health.
2. Pre-trial- a proceeding held by a judge, arbitrator, etc., before a trial to simplify the issues of law and fact and stipulate certain matters between the parties, in order to expedite justice and curtail costs at the trial.
3. Assess- to estimate or judge the value, character, etc., of; evaluate:
4. Low- in or to a low position, point, degree, etc. of less than average height from top to bottom or to the top from the ground.
5. Samples- a small part of anything or one of a number, intended to show the quality, style, or nature of the whole; specimen.
6. In addition- as an extra person, thing, or circumstance.
7. Gut- the alimentary canal, especially between the pylorus and the anus, or some portion of it.
8. Control group- a group of subjects closely resembling the treatment group in many demographic variables but not receiving the active medication or factor under study and thereby serving as a comparison group when treatment results are evaluated.
9. Further- at or to a more advanced point; to a greater extent
10. Rather- used to indicate one's preference in a matter.
11. Such as- to the same degree, amount, or extent; similarly; equally
12. Lifestyle- the habits, attitudes, tastes, moral standards, economic level, etc., that together constitute the mode of living of an individual or group.
13. Furthermore- moreover; besides; in addition
14. Applied to- (of a subject or type of study) put to practical use as opposed to being theoretical.
15. Issues- the act of sending out or putting forth; promulgation; distribution
